INDEPENDENT FUNERAL DIRECTORS

STANDARD PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only) This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	£2,995
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£1,445
Collecting and transporting the deceased persons from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£320
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's premises at Norfolk Lane, Cleethorpes, DN35 8BB	£320
Providing a suitable coffin - this will be made from oak veneer	£465
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	No Charge
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£445
UNATTENDED FUNERAL This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£1,650
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee) 2	£2,321
FEES YOU MUST PAY	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee. 1 In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee is:	£1,013
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	
For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee. 2 In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation is:	£655 - £933

This funeral director can supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or can arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. A complete list of these products and services is available on request.	
Additional transfer of the deceased person's body (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship etc), price per transfer	£445
Collection and delivery of ashes (locally)	No charge
Embalming	£150
Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc)	£200 - £250
Services supplied outside of normal office hours	Prices on request
The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.	
1. This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for re-opening and closing an existing grave.	
2. In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for one doctor to sign the Medical Certificates of Cremation.
